Per Barrier Free Canada, the following has been added to the report <u>CAIP Lanyers'</u> <u>Panel: Legislative Recommendations, August 2017</u>.

Communications and Media:

The internal workings of the Government of Canada must also be made accessible. Sufficient funding must be provided and changes should begin immediately. The affected realms include, for instance:

- Internal systems
- Internal websites
- Internal on-line forms
- Internal documents
- Internal applications.

Hiring of persons with disabilities should be a priority for the Government of Canada, and they should be included in a meaningful fashion. Amendments to the <u>Public Service</u> <u>Employment Act</u> may not be necessary if sufficient regulations can be enacted.
